The 2nd International Workshop on Spatial Data Quality will be held at the [Valletta Campus](#), Old University Building, St Paul's Street, Valletta, Malta on the 6 – 7 Feb 2018.

Flying to Malta:

[AirMalta](#) has direct flights to many major European airports including London, Frankfurt, Vienna, Brussels and Paris. Major airlines that fly here include Lufthansa, British Airways, and Alitalia, as do a number of low-cost airlines such as Ryanair, Wizzair and Norwegian. However February is low season, so some airlines would be on their less frequent winter schedule.

Hotels:

We have not selected a conference hotel, and you are free to make your own booking at a hotel of your choice. There are many hotels in Valletta, a few in and around are ones selected below. Valletta is a small city, so nothing is really very far!

Please note that [Valletta is European City of Culture 2018](#), so room bookings can be sparse, and may be more expensive. An option to consider is staying in Sliema, which is only a 20 minute bus ride or 10 minute ferry ride away from Valletta. Prices might be cheaper, but it is slightly further away, and public transport stops early (ferry at 19:00 and regular bus service at 23:00).

**Transport to/from airport:**

Public transport, the bus number X4 operates between the airport and Valletta, the bus time table and route can be found [here](#). Tickets are cheap Euro 1.50 or Euro 2.00 and can be bought either at the booth inside the terminal or directly from the driver. The buses to/from airport are not frequent however and the journey could be long and winding!

There is also an airport/hotel transfer service, they have a booth in the baggage claim area (only), on the left-hand side going down the escalator. This is a shared mini-bus service which will drop you off at or close to the hotel of your choice. The price should be in the region of Euro 8.00 one way, and Euro 16:00 return. You can also pre-book a taxi to come for you at the airport, the price is in the region of Euro 20 or less if outside peak time.
