INSPIRE Directive :

2017 : annex I themes

2020 : annex II and II themes

- ELF project
 - Includes themes AD, AU, BU, CP, GN, HY, TN, EL
 - Interoperable data expected by end 2015
- INSPIRE MIG Thematic Clusters
 - To collect implementation experiences and requests for change
 - Duration : end 2014 2015 (?)



CONTEXT: INSPIRE KEN ACTIVITIES

- Interoperability in general
 - NMCA strategy to implement INSPIRE interoperability (February 2013)
 - Schema transformation (October 2013)
 - Coordination between data producers for interoperability (February 2014)
- Interoperability of specific themes
 - HY and TN : October 2014 (Praha)
 - Other vector themes: April 2015 (Praha)
 - Raster themes EL and OI: 28-29 September 2015 (Barcelona)
