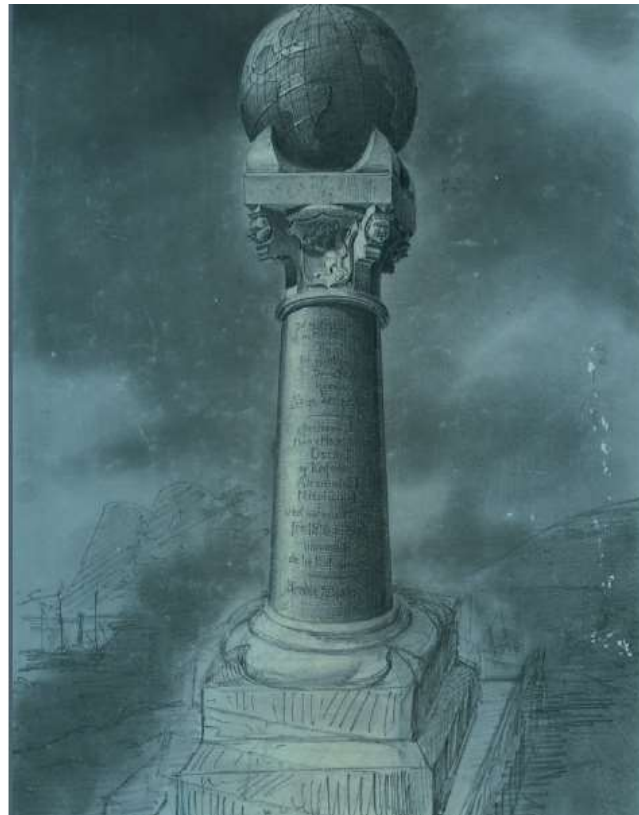

Struves meridianbue

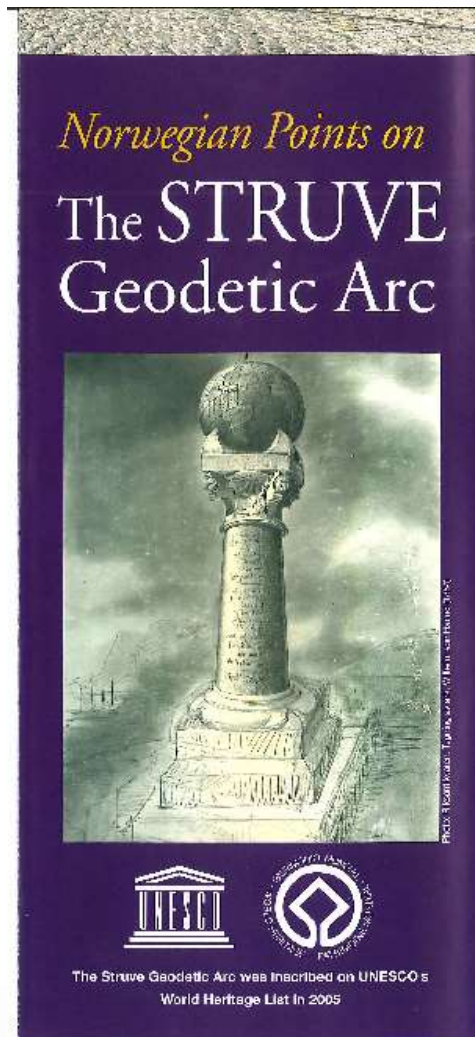


General
