

Communication Workshop of the Positioning Knowledge Exchange Network (PosKEN),

26-27 April 2018, Brussels (Belgium)

Background and objectives:

The aim of the EuroGeographics Positioning Knowledge Exchange Network (PosKEN) Communication Network Node is to improve communications between National Mapping and Cadastral Authorities (NMCAs) and the many bodies responsible for positioning and geodesy in Europe.

This PosKEN workshop will brief geodesy and GNSS experts from NMCAs on the European activities related to positioning, and discuss common trends and opportunities for a collaboration amongst key players in Europe.

EuroGeographics encourages NMCAs representatives and representatives from CLGE, EUREF, UNGGIM GGRF, EUPOS, GSA, FIG Commission V, EuroSDR and other key partners to maintain a comprehensive picture of the relevant positioning and geodetic projects and initiatives in Europe. This will be an opportunity to share experience, best practice from NMCAs on national achievements in geodesy, GNSS, metrology and other interesting affairs.

The workshop will be co-chaired by Hansjoerg Kutterer (Director General of BKG, Germany, Member of EueoGeographics Management Board) and Mick Cory (EuroGeographics Secretary General and Executive Director).

- EuroGeographics members, representatives of National Mapping and Cadastral Authorities (NMCAs), participating or being in charge of provision of GNSS related services, especially administrators of DGNSS/RTK networks.
- CLGE (Council of European Geodetic Surveyors), EUPOS (European Position Determination System) and EUREF (International Association of Geodesy, Reference Frame Sub-Commission for Europe) members interested or involved in cooperative activities between those organizations.
