What we mean with Plans and Regulations

- The real property register contains current information on the plans and regulations that apply to a specific property or a specific area.
- The plans and the rules governing the use of land and water. Examples of such plans and regulations,
 - municipal comprehensive plans
 - detailed plans
 - heritage cultural properties
 - nature conservation areas
 - ancient remains
 - work plans for roads
- Following information may also be included:
 - Game conservation areas
 - Fishing conservation areas






Contents in the Real property register

 Information on plans and regulations shows which plans and regulations are legally binding, indicative or binding for a particular property.


- Also included is information:
 - status
 - date of decision
 - file designatione.g. 0687-P242



- Register including cadastral index map.
- The file designation is a search key to the digital archive of Lantmäteriet.
- Having the file designation from the authority concerned you can ask for the plan or the regulation from their office.



Who makes the decisions?



- National level e.g. national parks
- Regional level the county administrative boards decides about e.g. different regulations
- Municipal level e.g. detailed plans






