What's going on?

- Europe
 - Uncertainty: no clear position of EC about future plans
 - Slow growth of content
 - Hardly any use of data
 - European institutions express a need, but no obligation
 - PSI vs INSPIRE

 - Technical: LOD, 3D, API, multichannel, sensors, crowd sourcing
 - Energy transition
 - Data driven policy

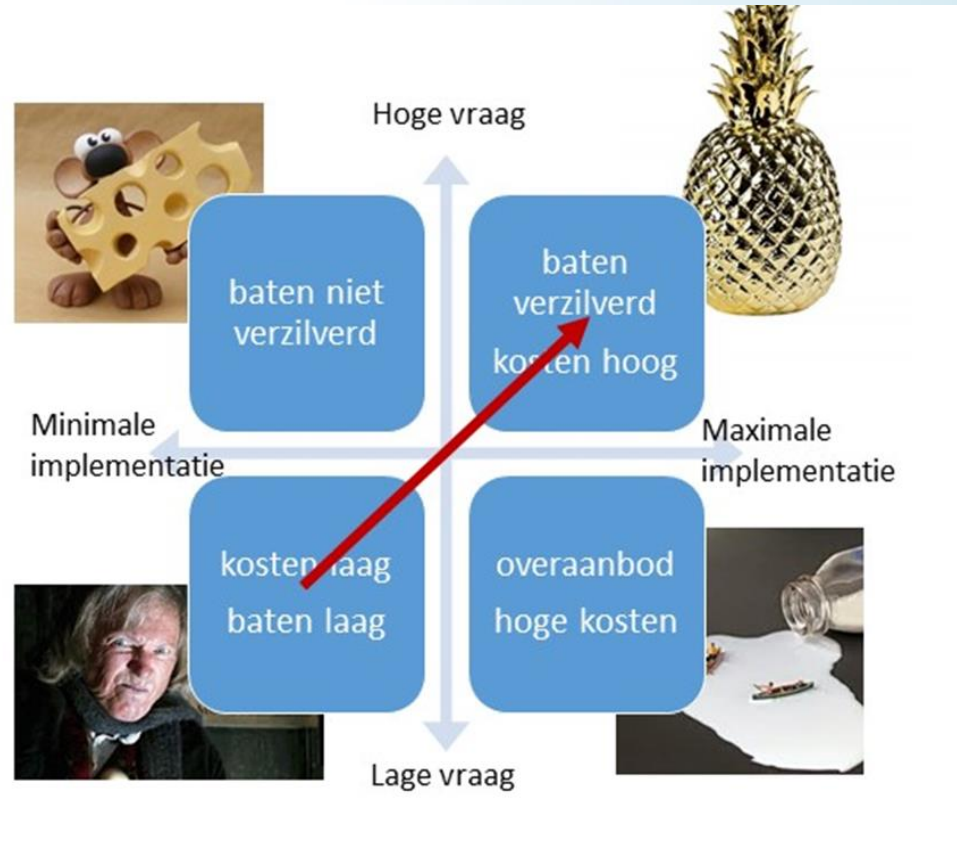
Research
