- We would like to release this product with **as much European coverage** as possible

Permission

- As providers of the EBM/ERM data we are asking **for permission** to include your data
- Only a small part of EBM/ERM data is needed
- The EBM/ERM data will be generalized
- No original geometry of the features with geographical names will be used
- Only reference points will be provided by the OpenELS Regional Gazetteer
- This is the same approach as for EGM, which is generalized from ERM and published by EuroGeographics as an open data product
- **To do this we need your permission**

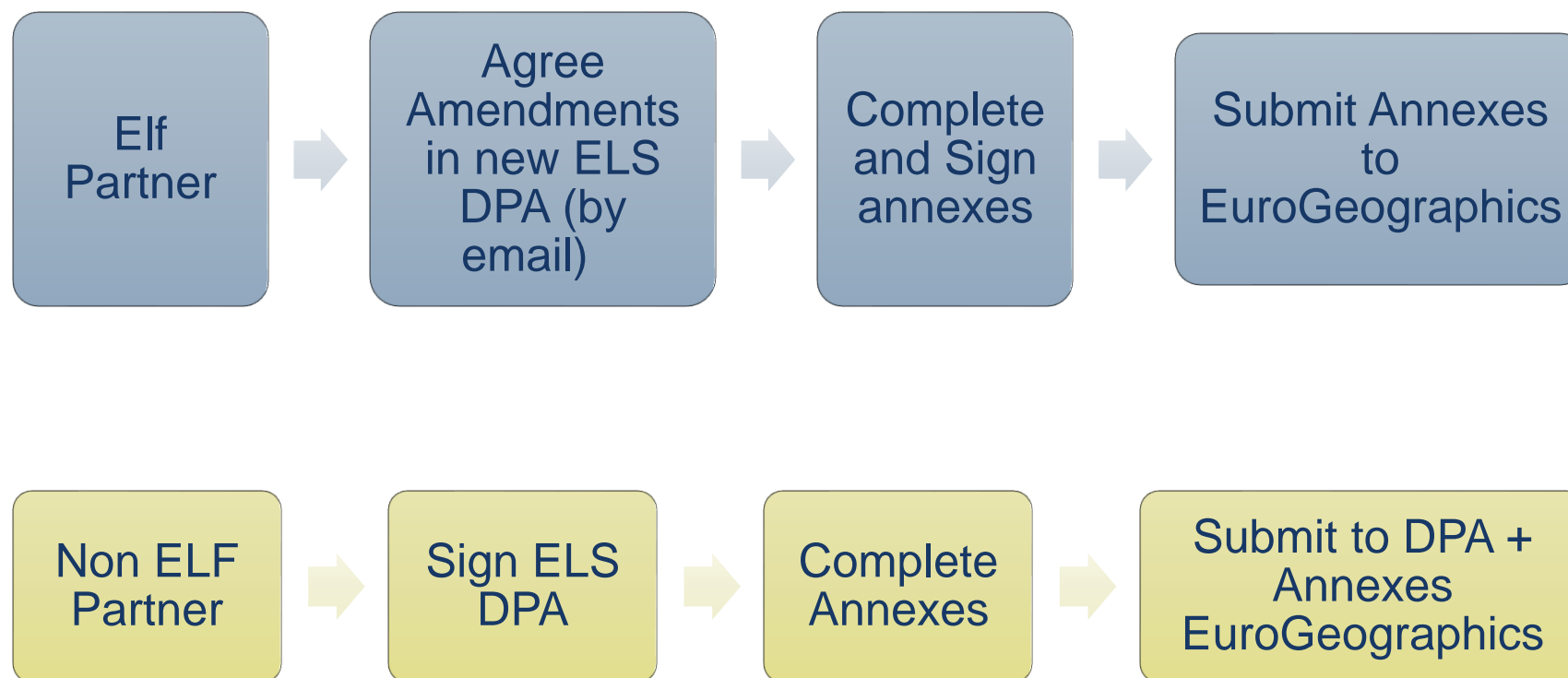
How to give permission

- Sign the ELS data provider Agreement (if necessary)
- Complete Annex I: List of the Data Providers Data and Services for ELS for OpenELS Regional Gazetteer as below

Dataset	Theme	Service type or data format	OpenELS Service	Comments
Name of dataset, for example Country EBM/ERM contribution (source: TBC)	OpenELS Regional Gazetteer	WFS, Applicable by ELS Geolocator	YES	Pan-European gazetteer in regional level of detail derived from EBM/ERM Please also indicate here if you are not the data owner

- **Complete Annex III IF RELEVANT**
 - Annex III is required if Annex I lists any of ELS Data and Services that require the grant of sub-licences. We suspect this would not be required for this but please check. This section is only applicable if the dataset/service being provided to ELS requires compensation for sublicensing in the form of a royalty to the Data Provider
- **Complete Annex IV: Restrictions and attribution requirements for ELS Data and Services.**
 - This should detail any special restrictions or attribution information
 - If required, it should at least include any national restrictions and attribution requirements for the data listed in Annex I when this is required by the Data provider or the Data Owner.
