








Next steps - Cadastral Index Map

- Part of activity 2; Create a new supply chain for the Cadastral Index Map (CIM)
- This will be completed by the sub-contractor
- Aim is to create technical process that can be scaled up
- Held initial Discovery sessions with Cadastral members
- Sent out cadastral survey to members
- Have initially selected 7 members to focus on:
 - Data is open, Metadata is available and ATOM feeds are available
 - Subcontractor is currently accessing and reviewing the ATOM feeds
 - Update cycle will be 6 months
- Will be included in next release of OME in Feb 2022.

- Global Geodetic Reference Frame)





Paulina supports the Finance, Compliance and Office Management Team in all tasks related to accounting and financial reporting. She is also involved in administrative, HR and governance matters.


