





Danish cadaster – 3 main elements




The Cadastral Register identifies the land parcels by number and area + other information



The Cadastral Map geographically identifies the land parcels



The Cadastral Archive contains measurement sheets identifying the position of the property boundaries


The Cadastral Register, digital 1986

- Cadastral identification 2 identification numbers
 - BFE-number unique number for all kind of real property
 - Cadastral Number and Cadastral District to each parcel in a Property of land parcels
- The size (area) of the parcel
- Area of roads
- Area regulation
 - Farming restriction (duty to maintain farming)
 - Forest restriction (protected forests)
 - Restriction areas against the sea
 - Restriction areas against dunes
- Administrative informations for internal use only

Cadastral Archives Online

- From 2012 2017 Cadastral physical archives was scanned and made accessible online (license)
 - More than 4 shelf kilometres of documents and measurement sheets was scanned
- Historical analogue cadastral maps until 2007 accessible online (open data)
- Historical digital cadastral map from 2008 will soon be accessible (open data)



Characteristics in the Danish Cadastral system

Public-private cooperation model:

- The Danish Geodata Agency
 - state authority for registration of real property (parcels, condominiums and building on leased land)
 - overall responsibility for the cadastral system, incl. the legislation (Act of subdivision, Chartered Surveyors Act)
- Chartered surveyors
 - monopoly to do cadastral work, incl. registration of condommiums and buildings on leased land

The chartered surveyor

Monopoly to do cadastral work

- Cadastral work must be performed by chartered land surveyors in private land surveying companies
- Licence to do castral work requires a 5 year academic education as land surveyor and practical work in a land surveing company in 3 years
- According the Land Surveyors Act

Cadastral work

- Define and mark the boundaries
- Make the documents and data to update the cadaster (register and map)
- Obtain permits to the cadastral changes from other authorities

Boundary disputes

- The landowners must apply to a chartered land surveyor, acting as a judge
- Formal process involving the landowners to achieve an agreement
- If agreement can not be reached the case goes to court
- Approx. 120-130 cases per year, less than 10 cases goes to court.
- Approx. 50 land surveying companies that annually submit approx. 9,000 cases for registration in the cadaster



Cadastral Registration in numbers

2024:

- Cadastral cases registret: 12.901
- New properties (parcels) registred: 7.523
- Number of area transfer: 5.312
- New condominiums: 12.752
- New buildings on leased land: 2.449
- Fees (parcels): 63.3 mio. kr.
- Fees (condominiums and buildings on leased land): 19.8 mio. kr.
- Tax per new properties, parcels (5.000 kr. each): 35.9 mio. kr.
- No tax for new condominiums and building on leased land




Denmark 45.000 km²


Property Registration is made in a private – public cooperation betwen the chartered land surveyor and DGA

DGA register cadastral changes, condominiums and buildings on leased land and maintain and improve the cadaster


CONTROL
