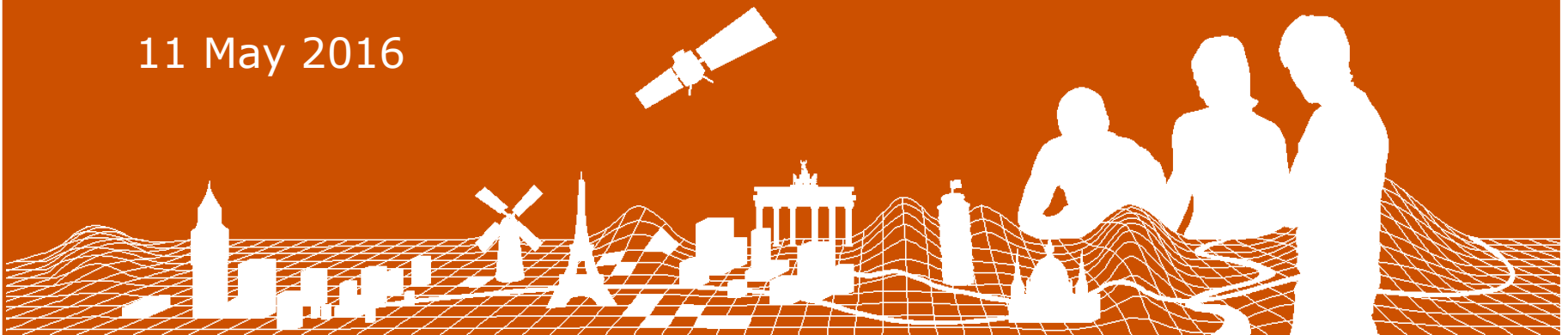

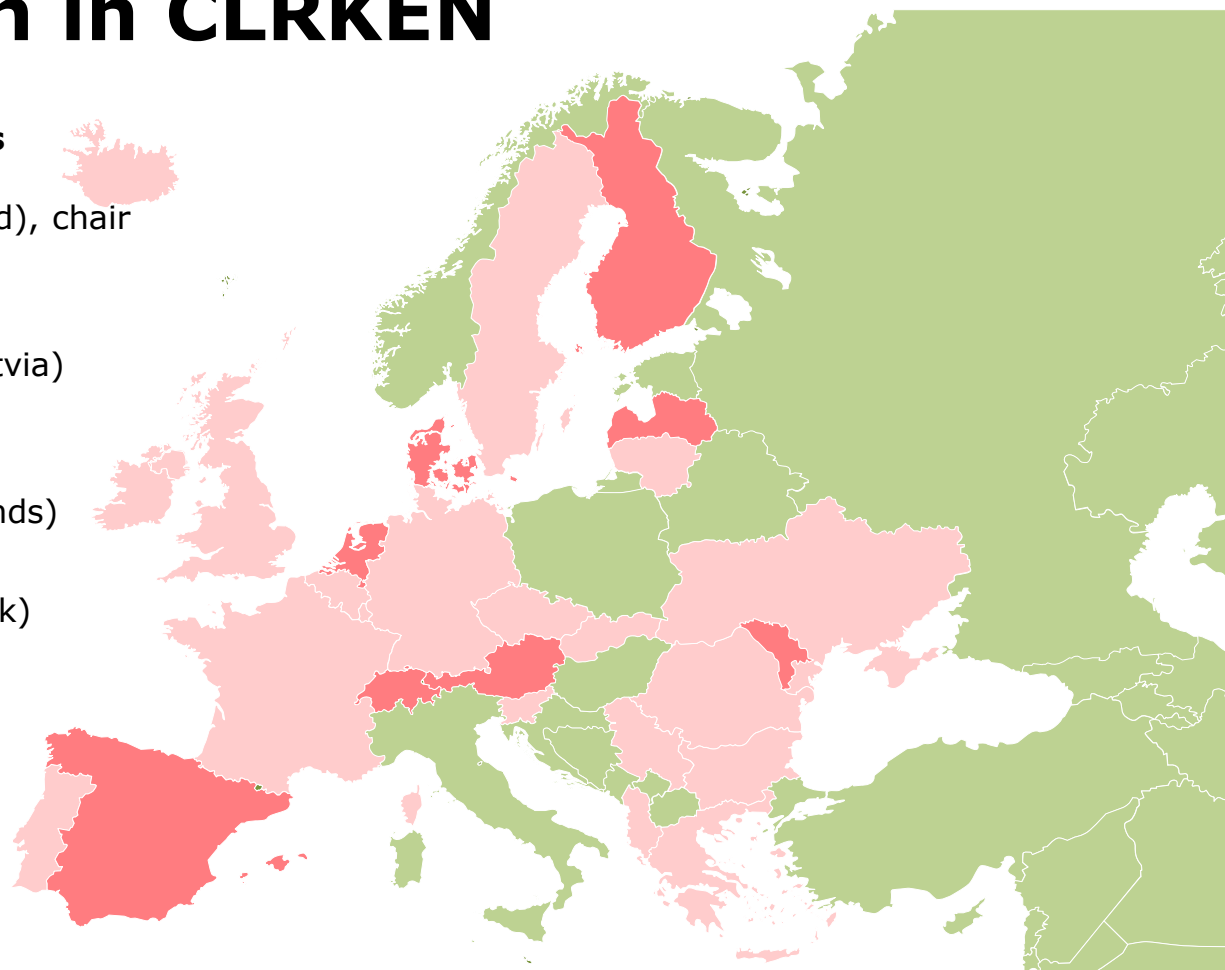

Main achievements in 2015

- 11/12 Nov. 2015: joint conference with EULIS, CLRKEN workshop on '[Documentation of Public-Law Restrictions](#)' (50 participants from 25 countries)
- 19/20 March 2015: Workshop on «[Beyond Limits - Developments in Cadastral Domain](#)», Zurich, Switzerland (60 participants from 20 countries)



Work Plan 2016/2017

- Overview of future workshop themes based on users' response
- June 2016: participation in Common Vision Conference 2016 in Amsterdam
- Nov. 2016: joint conference with PCC and EULIS in Bratislava
- 2017: cooperation with PCC-Presidencies of Malta and UK
- further develop the relevance of cadastre and land registry issues in member countries
- continue with workshops
- reinforce cooperation with PCC and others



Conclusions

- Cadastre and Land Registry is of value to NMCAs mainly because of the crucial role of geo-referenced land ownership information in spatial data infrastructures;
- the better this information is linked with other land related information, the more efficient land administration and land management, and the more spatially enabled a society and government will be;
- challenge: on the European level, the CLRKEN is only one among several players in the cadastral field → this is an opportunity at the same time
- members should actively participate in order to contribute to knowledge, to learn from each other, and to make an impact; this can be reached with a well established and active network among ourselves

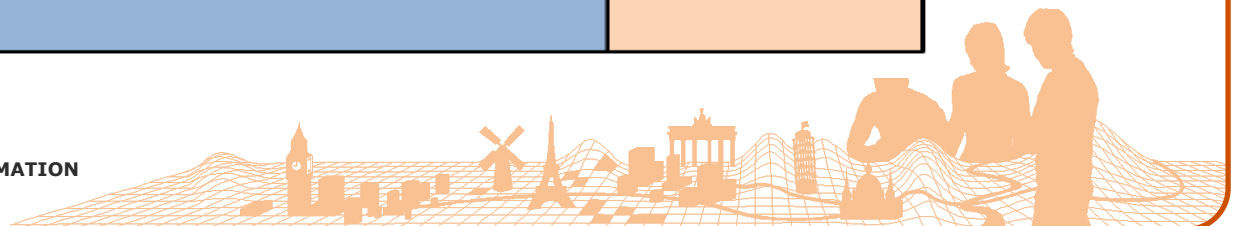
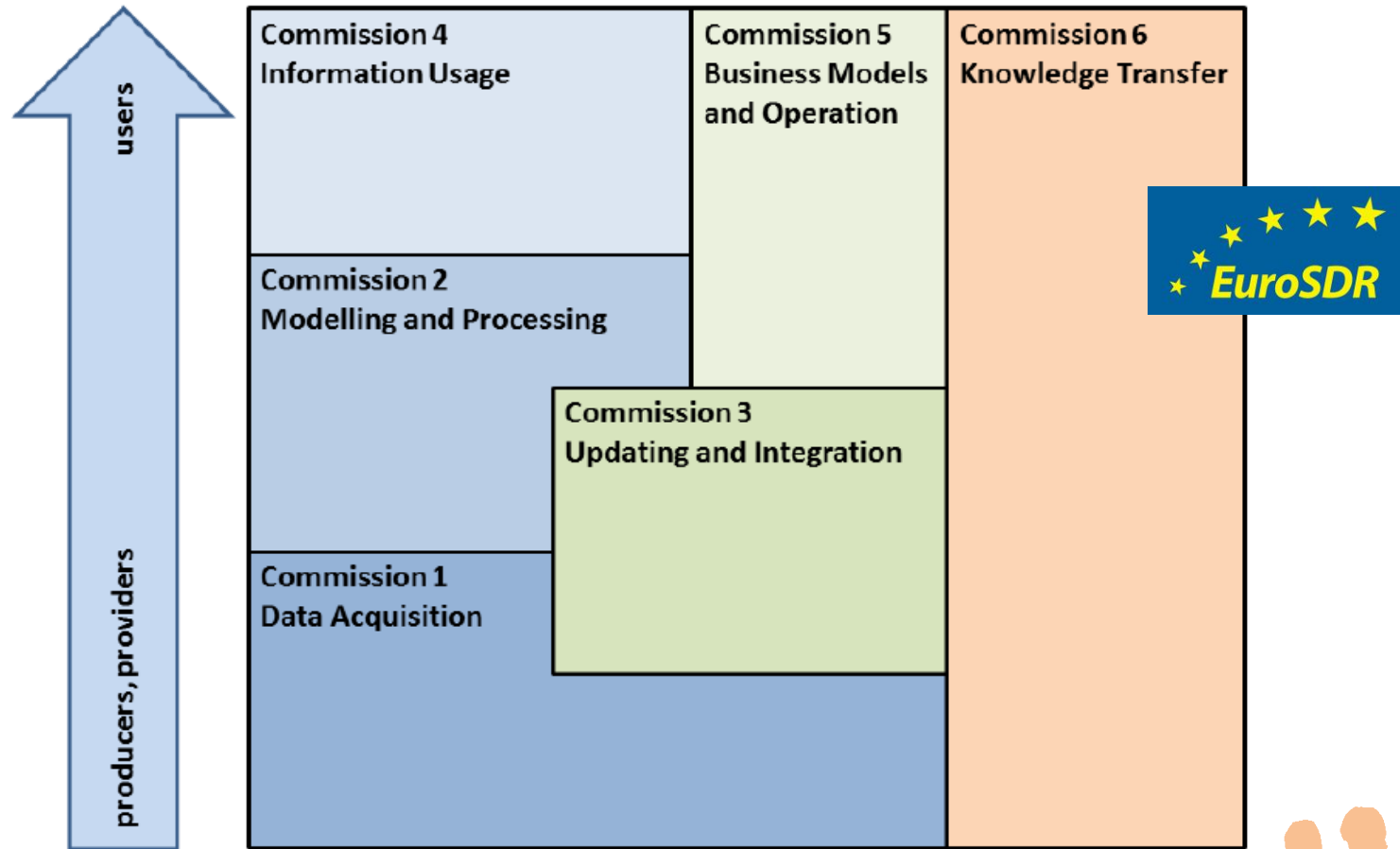

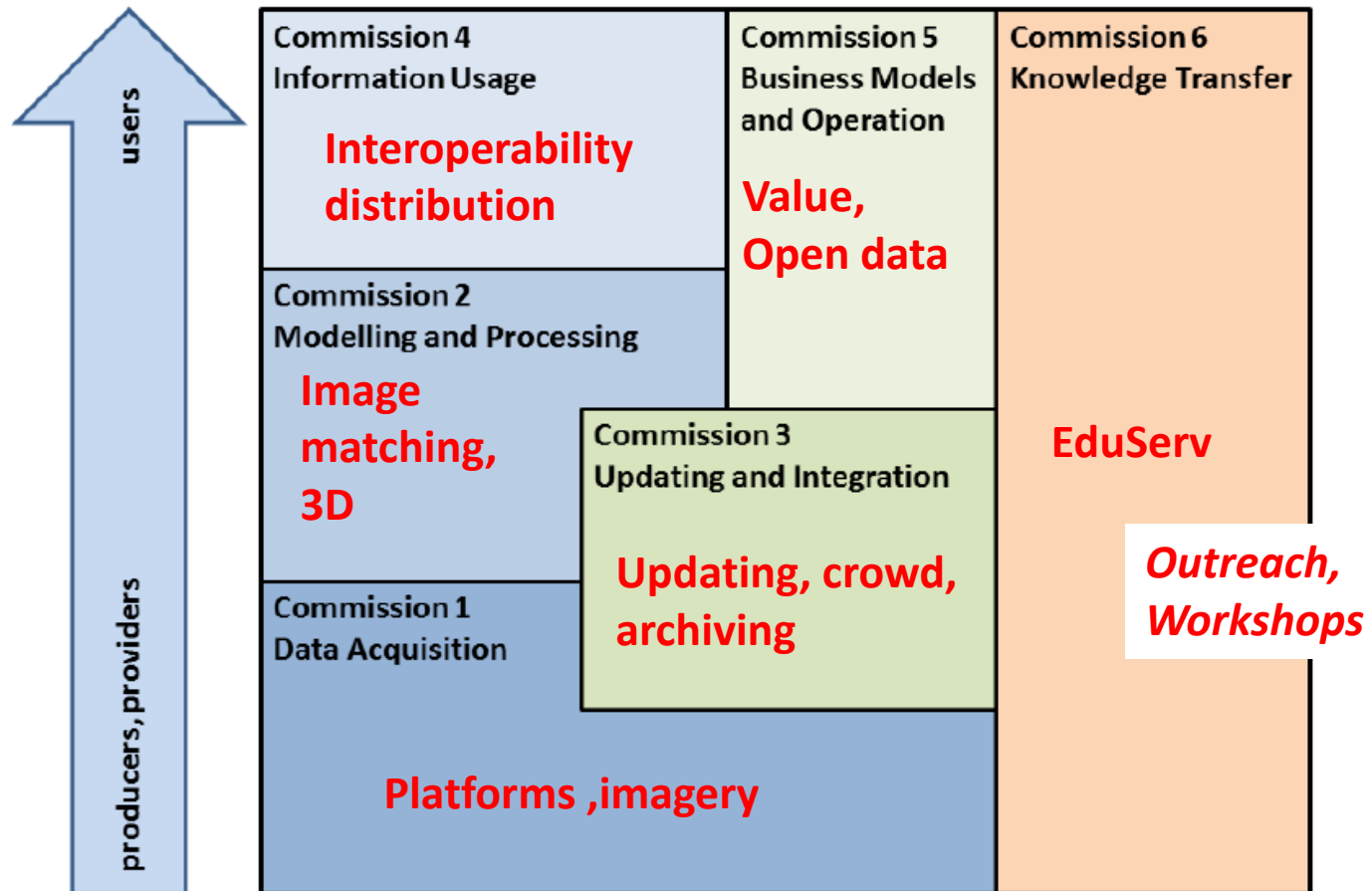
