- Data supply to required specifications
- Consent from members to allow us to release under an open license

### **Objective:**

- Migrate current ELF Data providers onto the new ELS DPA
- Arrange for signature for new ELS Data Providers

## Open ELS First release: Q3 2018

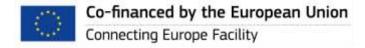
#### Services to be included in first release are:

- Addresses,
- Buildings,
- Transport Rail,
- Transport Road,
- Cadastral index Map
- Open ELS Regional Gazetteer\*

#### Target members for first release are:

- Czech Republic
- Denmark
- Finland
- Norway
- Spain (CNIG)
- Spain (SDGC)
- The Netherlands
- Belgium

# How to complete ELS DPA

## **Existing ELF Partners**

- Have already signed the ELF DPA within the ELF project
- Agree to the amended ELS DPA.
- We just need email confirmation that you accept these changes, it does not require signature as your organisation has already signed this.
- To allow us to include your services within Open ELS AND
  / OR ELS Services for Evaluation and Development
  purposes we need you to complete, sign and return the
  appropriate annexes of this new ELS Data Provider
  Agreement.

# How to complete ELS DPA

## **New ELS / Open ELS Data Providers**

- Sign the new ELS Data Provider agreement
- Complete annexes
- This includes those contributing to the Gazetteer only

#### **ELS DPA Annexes**

- Annex I: List of the Data Providers Data and Services for ELS / OpenELS including Open ELS Regional Gazetteer
- This should detail ALL services your organisation can supply for Open ELS and ELS
- Complete Annex III IF RELEVANT
- Annex III is required if Annex I lists any of ELS Data and Services that require the grant of sub-licences.
- We suspect this would not be required for this but please check. This section is only applicable if the dataset/service being provided to ELS requires compensation for sublicensing in the form of a royalty to the Data Provider
- Please complete Annex IV: Restrictions and attribution requirements for ELS Data and Services.
- This should detail any special restrictions or demands for attribution (naming) If required, it should at least include any national restrictions and attribution requirements for the data listed in Annex I when this is required by the Data provider or the Data Owner.

# Open ELS Regional Gazetteer

- We want to include the Open ELS Regional Gazetteer within the first release of products
- This gazetteer shall utilize the content of geographical names from EBM/ERM.

#### Main characteristics are:

- full European coverage (pan-European),
- regional LoD (level of detail) based on the existing EG products,
- direct use of INSPIRE data model GN,
- open data
- realization in short-term,
- linking of exonyms and variant names (outcome of the project EuroGeoNames)
- publishing as WFS on the ELS platform,
- applicable by the ELS Geolocator.

# Open ELS Regional Gazetteer

- The content of geographical names from EBM/ERM will be automatically transformed to the OpenELS Regional Gazetteer.
- Only a small part of EBM/ERM data is needed and the EBM/ERM data will be generalized.
- No original geometry of the features with geographical names will be used; instead only reference points will be provided by the OpenELS Regional Gazetteer.
- A detailed specification of the OpenELS Regional Gazetteer is in development.
- There is no technical input or action required from the NMCAs.
- The only request is that we asks you as providers of the EBM/ERM data for permission to use the name content for the OpenELS Regional Gazetteer as open data.
- This is the same approach as for EGM, which is generalized from ERM and published by EuroGeographics as an open data product.

## Open ELS Regional Gazetteer

If you are happy to give us this permission please do the following:

- Complete, sign and return the ELS Data provider relevant Annexes
- If you have not already agreed to the changes / signed the new ELS DPA you will need to
  do this
- Complete Annex I: List of the Data Providers Data and Services for ELS for OpenELS Regional Gazetteer:
